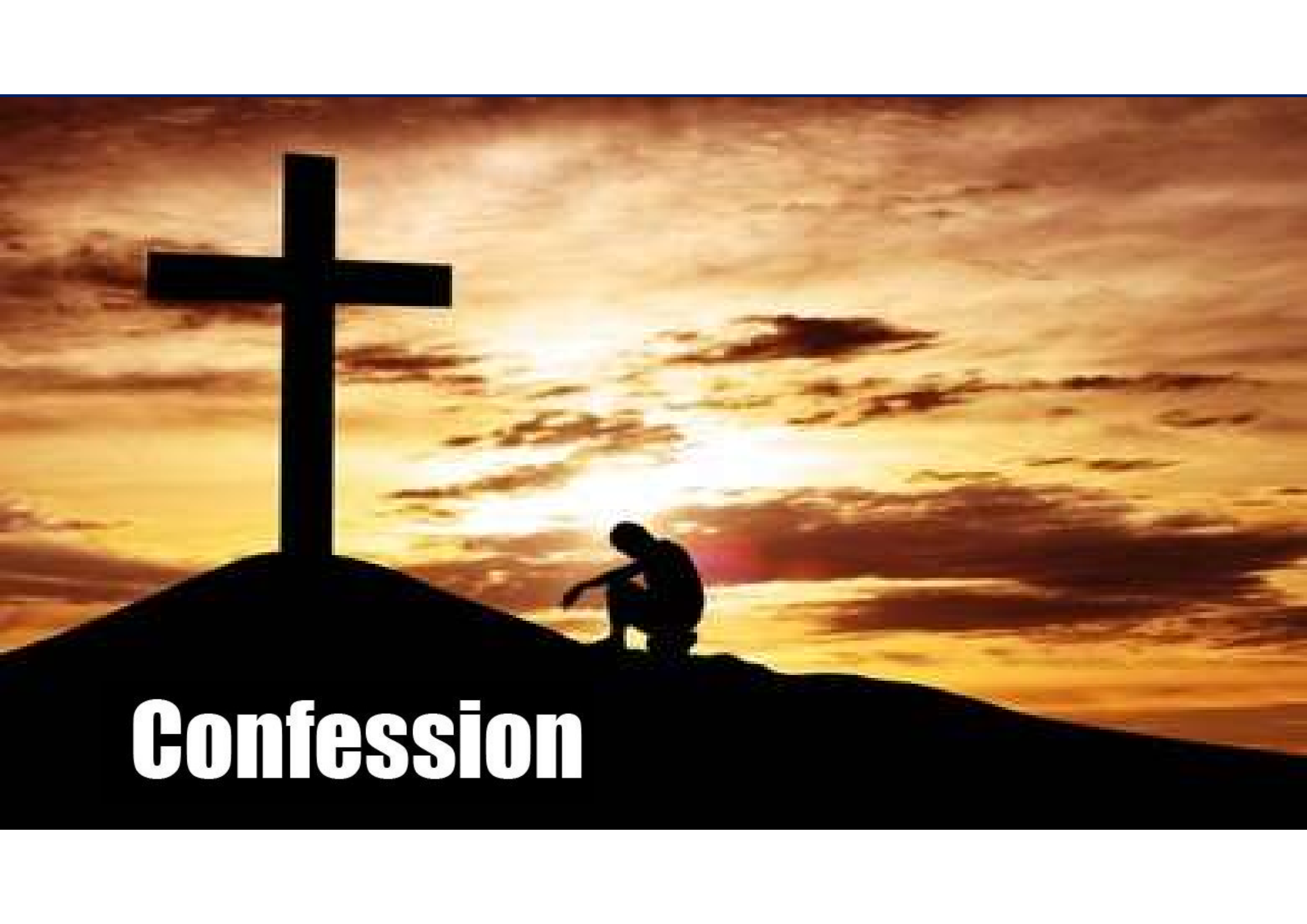

## Reading and Talk – Psalm 62

<sup>1</sup> Truly my soul finds rest in God; my salvation comes from him.  
<sup>2</sup> Truly he is my rock and my salvation; he is my fortress, I shall never be shaken. <sup>3</sup> How long will you assault me? Would all of you throw me down – this leaning wall, this tottering fence?  
<sup>4</sup> Surely they intend to topple me from my lofty place; they take delight in lies. With their mouths they bless, but in their hearts they curse. <sup>5</sup> Yes, my soul, find rest in God; my hope comes from him. <sup>6</sup> Truly he is my rock and my salvation; he is my fortress, I shall not be shaken. <sup>7</sup> My salvation and my honour depend on God; he is my mighty rock, my refuge.

**<sup>8</sup> Trust in him at all times, you people; pour out your hearts to him, for God is our refuge. <sup>9</sup> Surely the lowborn are but a breath, the highborn are but a lie. If weighed on a balance, they are nothing; together they are only a breath. <sup>10</sup> Do not trust in extortion or put vain hope in stolen goods; though your riches increase, do not set your heart on them. <sup>11</sup> One thing God has spoken, two things I have heard: 'Power belongs to you, God, <sup>12</sup> and with you, Lord, is unfailing love'; and, 'You reward everyone according to what they have done.'**
